### **THE LODGE**

#### *Business Casual*

NO BASEBALL CAPS, HATS  
OR BANDANAS AT THE LODGE

SHORTS MAY BE WORN IN THE  
SUMMER (see what not to wear  
for additional info)

- **MEN:** khakis & polo or button down shirt, casual dress pants
- **LADIES:** dark pants and dress shirt or sweater; knee length or longer skirt. Dress Capri pants are acceptable.

### **THE CREEKSIDE**

#### *Casual — yet Modest*

- Jeans or other casual pants
- Shorts in the summer (see what not to wear for additional info)
- Casual shirts including t-shirts (see what not to wear for additional info)

### **WHAT NOT TO WEAR**

#### *BOTH Locations*

- No low cut blouses, tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts or sleeveless shirts.
- No tight-fitting clothes.
- No short shorts or short skorts. Fingertips should be above the bottom of shorts or skorts when standing with arms at side.
- No clothing with offensive language or promoting persons, bands or products that are offensive.
